
Russian Society of Subsoil Use Experts (OERN)

- Has 1200 members. In 2014 new members were admitted.









- Registered Members must agree to practice according to a code of ethics which includes

 agencies.

The Registered Members Committee consists of five Registered Members that review applications. The Reserve Committee consists of fifteen SME Members that review issues related to public reporting of Reserves and Resources, including periodic updating of the SME Guide. These Committees contain representatives of metals, coal and industrial minerals mining; Committee representatives have qualifications in the areas of geology, mining engineering and processing.

RE: OERN APPLICATION FOR RECOGNISED PROFESSIONAL ORGANISATION STATUS

I am pleased to advise that the application by the Russian Society of Subsoii Use Experts (OERN) to be included in the Australian list of Recognised Professional Organisations (RPOs) has been approved and OERN will be included in the list to be published on the JORC and Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) website.

We anticipate this revised list will be dated 12 March 2014 and be available at http://www.jorc.org/competent.asp which will also include a link to the list on the ASX website.

As a courtesy I would like to remind you that the conditions for being included as a RPO are that a RPO must satisfy the following criteria:

- be a self-regulatory organisation covering professionals in the mining and/or exploration industry;
- admit members primarily on the basis of their academic qualifications and professional experience;
- require compliance with the professional standards of competence and ethics, established by the organisation, anywhere in the world (not just within the home jurisdiction of the organisation); and
- have disciplinary powers, including the power to suspend or expel a member for breaches of professional standards of competence or ethics anywhere in the world.

In addition as part of the agreement to establish the RPO system, the ASX requires that RPOs should not only be capable of dealing with ethical complaints made in respect of Competent Persons and the JORC Code, but that they are seen to be actively implementing this capability if any such complaints are made. Therefore each RPO has an obligation that if one of its members, acting as a Competent Person under the JORC Code, is reported to the RPO for alleged non-compliance with the JORC Code, and the RPO's investigations uphold the alleged non-compliance, this finding should be communicated to the Chair of JORC when requested annually.



JORC is pleased to include OERN in the list of RPOs. Inclusion in the RPO list allows OERN Experts with the required relevant experience to act as Competent Persons for public reporting in Australia.




Re: Recognition of NAEN Code as Accepted Foreign Code

I am pleased to respond on behalf of the British Columbia Securities Commission (BCSC) to your March 17, 2014 letter requesting recognition of the NAEN Code as an "accepted foreign code" under National Instrument 43-101 Standards of Disclosure for Mineral Projects (NI 43-101). I have also discussed your request with my geological colleagues at the Ontario Securities Commission (OSC) and the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF), and they are in agreement with the position set out herein. The BCSC, OSC and AMF collectively have primary jurisdiction over the majority of Canadian public mining companies and are responsible for the application and interpretation of NI 43-101 within our collective jurisdictions.

NI 43-101 defines an acceptable foreign code to include any code, generally accepted in a foreign jurisdiction, that defines mineral resources and mineral reserves in a manner that is consistent with the CIM Definition Standards. Section 1.1(1) of Companion Policy 43-101CP (the Companion Policy) provides further guidance to the effect that foreign codes will generally meet the test in the definitions if they

- a) have been adopted by appropriate government authorities ...
- b) use mineral resource and mineral reserve categories that are based on the CRIRSCO Template....

Based on our understanding and review of the NAEN Code and the related 2011 CRIRSCO-NAEN joint publication entitled *The Russian Code*, we are of the view that the NAEN Code meets the definition of accepted foreign code in NI 43-101.



Therefore the NAEN Code is acceptable for the purposes of NI 43-101, subject to the restrictions and provisions of Part 7 of NI 43-101 that apply to all foreign codes.

As stated in the Companion Policy, we will publish CSA Staff Notices periodically listing the codes that CSA members' staff think satisfies the definition. While we do not have plans to do so in the immediate future, we will not object to issuers using the NAEN Code in the meantime.

We also acknowledge the receipt of your separate March 17, 2014 letter regarding the request for recognition of OERN as a foreign association under NI 43-101. We have this matter under consideration and will be responding to your request in due course.
