#### 2014 SME Guide Issued

- The new 2014 SME Guide was issued June 10, 2014
- Re-aligned with CRIRSCO Template's updated Core Definitions
- New Table 2 guidance added for CAPEX and OPEX for Scoping, Pre-Feasibility and Feasibility
- Webinar hosted in July to review new guide with SME members





## SEC Tangible Progress



### Significant Progress made with the SEC in 2014

- SME partnered with the NMA to engage the House Financial Services Committee which has oversight over the SEC. SEC Chair met with the committee regarding the need to update IG7
- The SEC has posted an opening for an "Academic Fellow" to assist the staff in revising Industry Guide 7





# Mongolian Reporting Code Support

- Dr. Harry Parker has been working with Mongolian professional society (MIPGM) and Ministry of Mining to progress a Mongolian Code to ensure preparedness for this weeks meeting
- Recent progress builds on efforts in 2012-3 with the World Bank of and 2008 workshops with School of Geology and Petroleum Engineering (MUST)
