# PERC re-structuring

- Formal constitution
- Permanent office; secretariat
- Defined membership
- Funding: sponsorship etc.





### Formal constitution

- PERC asbl not-for-profit association registered in Belgium
- Office EFG, within Belgian Geological Survey building, Brussels
- Statutes, in French and English





## Defined membership

- Four founding organisations: each nominates four PERC members
  - European Federation of Geologists
  - Institute of Materials Minerals & Mining
  - The Geological Society
  - Institute of Geologists of Ireland
- Additional "special advisers" = co-opted members
- Inviting Euromines, IMA-Europe, Eurogeosurveys, FEANI,... to nominate additional members

### PERC 2012 Standard

- Consultation draft published 25 Feb. 2012
- Consultation closed 31 August (extended from 30 June)
- Submissions received, many suggestions incorporated into a revised draft





### PERC Standard 2012: main features

- CRIRSCO standard definitions
- Clause 9: tighter requirement to disclose any relationship between CP and company
- Competent Person definition simplified, RPOs listed in new Appendix 5
- Clarification of rules for reporting stockpiles (for construction raw materials in particular) to avoid double-counting
- Modifications for alignment with ESMA rules (materiality etc)
- Oil shales, tar sands; Solution mining
- Personal verification & site visits statement guidelines





#### **PERC** in 2013

- First meeting of new PERC: Brussels, Q1 2013
- Election of all officers: chair, secretary, treasurer, and CRIRSCO representatives
- Participation in bids for EU raw materials projects:
  - European Intelligence Network on the Supply of Raw Materials
  - European Innovation Partnership on Raw Materials
- Press for tighter regulation: ESMA, FSA, AIM ...





### Regulation

- 15 Oct 2012: Aurum Mining plc press release
  - Previous work on the Pino permit area has focused on the "El Facho" structure where drilling to date has enabled a preliminary non-compliant resource estimate of some 122,000-145,000 ounces of gold at average grades of approximately 1g/t.\*
  - \*This initial resource estimate was calculated by Aurum Exploration Services (the Irish based exploration consultants who are totally independent of the Company). It is important to note that this is an early stage resource estimation rather than being a resource that has been calculated in accordance with any internationally recognised standard.
