

Lucara Diamonds has recovered some of the largest diamonds to date at its Botswana Karowe mine including a 1 111 carat gem quality, Type IIa diamond, an 813 carat stone and a 374 carat stone.

The magnificent 1 111 stone, which originated from the south lobe of Karowe mine, is the world's second largest gem quality diamond ever recovered and the largest ever to be recovered through a modern processing facility.




